#### **ANNOUNCING CITIZENSHIP CLASSES AT CHBC**

Kentucky Refugee Ministries and Crescent Hill Baptist are teaming up to hold Citizenship Classes. Refugees who have been, or will soon be, in the United States for 5 years are eligible to apply for citizenship. This class is to prepare for a test and an interview before the application is approved. KRM will provide the teacher and the materials. Crescent Hill will provide the space and child care. The classes will be held on Sunday afternoons from 12:30-2:30 PM in the Youth Lounge. All participants are responsible for their and their children's snack/lunch and need to bring pencil and paper or notebook. Transportation will be primarily through individual cars, providing and sharing rides, and public transportation.
