LGBT CONVERSATIONS BEGIN

This Wednesday evening we begin a series of conversations as we seek to clarify our church's relationship with lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgendered individuals. A letter was mailed to members last month outlining the background and details of the process. Extra copies are available in the church office. The Church Council requests your prayerful consideration throughout this time of discernment.

The schedule for the conversations is:

4/10 — What Welcoming and Affirming Means: The Framework and Ground Rules for Sessions and Prayer

4/17 – The Bible and Homosexuality

4/24 – Sexuality and Gender

5/8 — My Journey – An evening where someone beyond the church will share their experiences of how the church has hurt and helped them as a LGBT person.

5/15 – An Opportunity To Share Session I – Anyone will be invited to share their understanding of scripture, theological perspective, and personal stories about this issue. Anyone can share anything they wish, BUT NO VALUE JUDGMENTS PERMITTED. This is a time to share honestly with one another and listen compassionately to one another, even if we vehemently disagree with one another.

5/29 – An Opportunity To Share Session II

6/5 - A Night of Discernment – A time to gather together, not to share opinions or perspectives, but to ask God for clear discernment and silence.
