Congregants will note a certain starkness in décor as we prepare the sanctuary for the transforming reflection of the season. The first Sunday in Lent brought down the bells, bright ribbons and banner days, all to be stored away for the season as our way of letting the Alleluia fall silent for a fallow

period. The first candle of the Lenten wreath was snuffed. Each subsequent Sunday will increase the darkness, and the altar table will be marked with a symbol of the hard times and hard words on the way to Gethsemane on Maundy Thursday, March 28, and Golgotha on Good Friday, March 29.

#### FROM THE FINANCE TEAM

#### 2012 ENDED ON A HIGH NOTE

Thanks to your generosity, Crescent Hill Baptist Church finished 2012 in excellent financial shape. In 2012, we projected a total income of \$602,093. We received \$660,229. In addition to higher than expected revenue, due in large part to wise spending by our Ministry Teams, our expenses were well

below what was budgeted for 2012. Our total expenses were \$603,027 in 2012.

While we are delighted to share this good news with the congregation, we also want to encourage continued faithful giving. Because we ended 2012 with a budget surplus, we are now in a position to dream bigger about the ways in which we can

use our resources to share God's love with one another and our community. For instance, because we ended 2012 with a surplus, we may be able to use a portion of those funds to pay for some renovations in our entry areas in our building and support other new ministries. Thank you for your generous giving. Thank

you to those who have been wise stewards of the gifts given to God through Crescent Hill Baptist Church. May we continue to give faithfully so that we can dream bigger and do more for the sake of sharing God's love.

#### GIFT RECEIVED FROM ESTATE OF ADA LEE KANE

The church has received a generous gift from the estate of Ada Lee Kane. Ms. Kane requested that those funds be put into the church's Capital Needs Improvement Endowment. Thanks to Ms. Kane's thoughtfulness and generosity before her death, she will continue to support the work and ministry of our family of faith for years and years to come. Crescent Hill Baptist Church has several

endowments to which you may contribute. The Capital Needs Improvement Endowment is currently valued at \$1,363,370. Funds in this endowment over the principal, which currently sits at \$1,255,425, can only be used for projects related to our building or other capital needs. Recently, the church established a Ministry and Missions Endowment. This endowment currently

contains \$12,803. In an effort to grow this endowment, current church policy states that 85% of any undesignated bequests made to the church will be allocated to the Ministry and Missions Endowment. The remaining 15% of the bequest will go into the church's general operating fund. This Endowment can be used to support any ministry project conducted by the church.

# REVISED FINANCIAL POLICIES TO BE VOTED UPON AT MINISTRY FORUM

Over the course of the past year, the Finance Team has worked hard to update our church's financial policies. The revisions to our church's financial policies will be voted upon at the March Ministry Forum. Copies of the revised policies are available in the church office.





#### ENTRY POINT ENHANCEMENT CONTINUES TO MOVE FORWARD

After months and months of planning, the ad hoc group that has been working on making some enhancements to entry points in the building is ready to begin the first phase of the project.

We are blessed to be a welcoming and hospitable congregation that goes out of its way to make people feel at home at CHBC. We are also blessed with a wonderful, functional physical environment at Crescent Hill Baptist Church. Our sanctuary, Fellowship Hall, chapel, gym, educational venues for children, youth, and adults, all serve us very well. However, improvements can be made in order to help people who want to come to our church better enter the building, feel more welcome once they enter, and better navigate their way through the building once they are inside. The first step in the project to improve our several entry areas will be the construction of an airlock (an additional set of doors and an entry area) under the Birchwood Lobby porch. Before warming the lobby with a fresh coat of paint and new lighting,

the air-lock will ensure that the lobby stays warmer in the winter and cooler in the summer.

The air-lock is projected to cost \$8,500. Construction costs will be covered by gifts given by individuals and from funds allocated to this project from the church's Memorial Gifts fund. Barring any unforeseen problems, this air-lock will likely be completed in early March. The air-lock is seen as a first step

in a multi-step process.
Regardless as to what happens with the later phases, the group feels like the air-lock is worth pursuing, even if nothing else happens. However, the hope is that more will happen. Hopefully, this project will include all of the following:

## Phase 2 (potentially completed this spring)

- paint Birchwood Lobby
- paint hallway outside of nursery and leading to nursery area
- new ceiling tile in lobby and nursery area
- new lighting in lobby and nursery area
- new furniture in lobby

- new appointments in lobby and nursery area
- new carpet in nursery area
- landscaping improvements leading up to lobby
- new interior signage

## Phase 3 (potentially completed by the end of summer)

- paint hallway from Birchwood lobby to Chapel and leading up stairs from Church Office to Sanctuary
- new flooring
- · new ceiling tile
- · new lighting
- new appointments

#### Phase 4

 similar upgrades in Fellowship Hall entry area

The total cost of phases 2 through 4 has yet to be determined. As soon as a firm figure for those phases comes into focus, a presentation will be made to the congregation about the details of the project and the congregation will be asked to approve the project before moving ahead. If you have further questions or suggestions, do not hesitate to speak with Bob Hieb, Beverly Baker or Jason Crosby.
